The Council held a secret session this afternoon. Viscount Ishii's report for the re-appointment of the present High Commissioner for Danzig for one year was approved.

The Secretary-General stated that he understood that General Haking might possibly find it necessary to resign in the course of the year, but if he did so he would take every precaution to give the Council of the League adequate notice.

The Marquis Imperiali proposed that Signor Perelli should be appointed to take the place of Senator della Torre on the Provisional Economic Committee of the League.

This was unanimously agreed to.

The question of the publication of Colonel Chardigny's report was brought up, and it was decided that for the time being it should be considered as strictly confidential, the decision of the Council being left to a later date.
